My name is Bob Moran. I was born on Adams St. Rox. 1951 in OPP. I just came across your website. I was touched by your remembrance of your brother Steven. My family and I remember the day Steven died. We were all shocked. We never forgot Steven whenever we reminisced about Roxbury.
